

## CLASS ACTION NOTICE

### **Réal Marcotte and Bernard Laparé v. Amex Bank of Canada (“AMEX”)**

#### **HAVE YOU USED YOUR PERSONAL AMEX CREDIT CARD FOR FOREIGN EXCHANGE TRANSACTIONS BETWEEN APRIL 2000 AND JANUARY 2003?**

#### **THIS NOTICE MAY BE OF INTEREST TO YOU**

#### **JUDGMENT**

On September 19, 2014 the Supreme Court of Canada ordered **AMEX** to pay back foreign exchange conversion fees (“**FX Fees**”) charged to cardholders between April 17, 2000 and February 1, 2003. Amex was also ordered to pay exemplary damages in the amount of \$25 per class member with interest.

#### **WHO IS A MEMBER?**

You are a member if between **April 17, 2000 and February 1, 2003** you used a Personal American Express Credit Card for a purpose other than business:

- you were a resident in the Province of Quebec at the time you used your card;
- you were charged foreign exchange conversion fees for foreign exchange transactions between April 17, 2000 and February 1, 2003 and
- the fees charged were paid.

#### **HOW TO FILE A CLAIM**

On May 5, 2015 the Court authorized the distribution protocol. If you are a Member, you must submit a claim to the Claims administrator The Bruneau Group on or before **February 4, 2016**. The claim can be submitted online or a paper claim form can be mailed to the **CLAIMS ADMINISTRATOR**. Claim forms are available at the website:
