### Settlement Agreement

The Agreement provides in particular for the payment of a total sum of 825,000 USD for the benefit of all persons residing in Quebec at the time of their reservation, who reserved accommodation on the Internet with BB between January 27, 2017 and November 20 2021.

# Objection to Agreement

Class members have the right to object to the Agreement. A class member will remain a class member whether or not they object to the Agreement. If the Settlement is approved by the Court, all class members who will receive compensation under the settlement will lose all rights to sue Benjamin & Brothers for displaying the price for an accommodation reservation on its website between January 27, 2017 and November 20, 2021.

If you wish to object to the Agreement, you must send a written objection no later than **May 19**<sup>th</sup>, **2023** by email to TJL at info@tjl.guebec or by fax at 514-871-8800.

TJL will provide the Court with a copy of all objections received within five (5) days of their reception and at the latest on May 19<sup>th</sup>, 2023. No opposition will be possible after this date. A written objection must include:

- your name, address, email and telephone number;
- a brief statement of the reasons for your objection; and
- if you intend to attend the hearing in person or through a lawyer. In the latter case, you must provide the name, address, email address and telephone number of the lawyer.

Class members who do not object to the proposed Agreement do not need to attend the Settlement Agreement approval hearing or take any other action at this time. If the Honorable Judge Martin F. Sheehan approves the Settlement, another notice will be published to inform you of the procedure and time limits for filing a claim.
